Request for Separate Session Information Sheet

Although most parents request to participate in a joint mediation session because this will allow them the opportunity to hear and immediately respond to the concerns presented by the other parent, in cases involving domestic violence and/or Restraining Orders please consider the following:

You are able to bring a <u>Support Person</u> to your counseling session.

Your Support Person may be present with you during the session to provide you with emotional support, but may not participate in the child custody recommending counseling session.

Absolutely no violence or aggressive dialogue will be tolerated during the session.

The counselor has the authority to excuse any parent that is unable to act appropriately during the session at any time.

County Sheriffs are available at all times and will immediately address any concerns or inappropriate behavior.

Per Family Code 3183(b) and Rule of the Court 5.215(d)(6), in cases where there are **sworn** *allegations* of domestic violence, the parties may each meet separately with the child custody recommending counselor.

Either you or the other party make allegations of domestic violence in *writing* and *swear under penalty of perjury* that the allegations are true.

The attached Request for Separate Counseling Sessions form is **signed under the penalty of perjury**
