Personally appeared before me, who first being duly sworn, complains and alleges:

COUNT 1

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Sebhrenah April Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that in this proceeding, the defendant Marcus Delon Wesson, has been convicted of more than one offense of murder in the first or second degree, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3).

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused death to Sebhrenah April Wesson within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

COUNT 2

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Elizabeth Breahi Kina Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that in this proceeding, the defendant Marcus Delon Wesson, has been convicted of more than one offense of murder in the first or second degree, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3).

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused death to Elizabeth Breahi Kina Wesson, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

COUNT 3

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Jeva St Vladensvspry Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused great bodily injury or death to Sedonia Solorio Wesson, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

COUNT 5

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Marshey St Christopher Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that in this proceeding, the defendant Marcus Delon Wesson, has been convicted of more than one offense of murder in the first or second degree, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3).

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused great bodily injury or death to Marshey St Christopher Wesson, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

COUNT 6

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Ethan St Laurent Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that in this proceeding, the defendant Marcus Delon Wesson, has been convicted of more than one offense of murder in the first or second degree, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3).

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused great bodily injury or death to Ethan St Laurent Wesson, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

COUNT 7

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Illabella Carrie Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that in this proceeding, the defendant Marcus Delon Wesson, has been convicted of more than one offense of murder in the first or second degree, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3).

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused great bodily injury or death to Illabella Carrie Wesson, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

COUNT 8

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Aviv Dominique Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that in this proceeding, the defendant Marcus Delon Wesson, has been convicted of more than one offense of murder in the first or second degree, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3).

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused great bodily injury or death to Aviv Dominique Wesson, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

COUNT 9

On or about March 12, 2004, in the above named judicial district, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a felony, was committed by Marcus Delon Wesson, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Johnathon St Charles Wesson, a human being.

It is further alleged that in this proceeding, the defendant Marcus Delon Wesson, has been convicted of more than one offense of murder in the first or second degree, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3).

It is further alleged that said defendant Marcus Delon Wesson personally and intentionally discharged a firearm which proximately caused great bodily injury or death to Johnathon St Charles Wesson, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.53(d).

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant personally used a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.5.

"NOTICE: Conviction of any offense as a felony in this complaint will require you to provide two specimens of blood, a saliva sample, right thumbprints, and a full palm print impression of each hand pursuant to Penal Code section 296."

All of which is contrary to the form, force, and effect of the Statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the people of the State of California.
