Due to the numerous public health and safety concerns the COVID-19 pandemic presents, and the proclamations of a state of emergency by Governor Newsom and President Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in Government Code section 68115 continue to be met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of Fresno.

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the judicial emergency order granted by Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council, the Court hereby extends the time period provided in section 825 of the Penal Code within which a defendant charged with a felony offense must be taken before a magistrate from 48 hours to not more than 7 days, applicable only to cases in

1 which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from June
2 20, 2020, to July 17, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, §
3 68115(a)(8)).
