An attorney can either use someone on the Real time Court Reporter Pro-Tempore Directory or bring their own reporter, as long as they are real time proficient.

If the party uses a reporter on the pre-qualified real time pro-tempore list, you will need to submit **Form PGN-59** Order Appointing Court Approved Reporter As Official Reporter Pro Tempore. The Order must be from the judge presiding in the department where the trial or hearing will take place, appointing the certified shorthand reporter to serve as an official court reporter pro tempore in a particular case is required. An Order will be submitted for each hearing. If it is for a trial, the Order can be submitted at the beginning of the trial and it is good for the duration of the trial as long as it is the same reporter.

When using a reporter that is not on the Court's pre-qualified real time pro tempore directory, you will need to submit **Form PGN-63** Stipulation and Order To Use Certified Shorthand Reporter FOR EACH AND EVERY HEARING. The stipulation should be arranged in advance of the hearing. An order from the judge presiding in the department where the trial or hearing will take place, appointing the certified shorthand reporter to serve as an official court reporter pro tempore in a particular case is also required. Orders (located on bottom portion of the Stipulation and Order form) may be obtained (signed) on the day of the hearing or trial by a party accompanied by the proposed certified shorthand reporter. The Court Reporter Agreement and the Stipulation of the Appearing Parties portions of the form must be completed. The Court Reporter **MUST** sign the Court Reporter Agreement. Stipulation of the Appearing Parties **MUST** be signed by the parties or their counsel appearing in the matter. A Stipulation and Order will be submitted for each hearing. If it is for a trial, the Stipulation and Order can be submitted at the beginning of the trial and it is good for the duration of the trial as long as it is the same reporter.
