

Paperless Court Reporter Transcripts

The Fresno Superior Court is kicking off a Pilot Project on July 1, 2014 to provide Court Reporter Transcripts electronically in criminal, juvenile delinquency and dependency cases. The court reporter transcripts will be uploaded to YesLaw, a secure online document repository, and an email will be generated for all parties selected for service. Within the body of the email will be a hyperlink to the YesLaw website. Additionally, the email will contain a password that will be entered on the YesLaw website to allow access to the transcript. Transcripts may be viewed within the YesLaw site or downloaded to a computer, laptop or tablet as an Adobe Acrobat PDF document. This PDF format has helpful features which allow word and phrase searches, the ability to cut and paste, and highlight, in addition to other options.
