IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR ZOOM HEARINGS

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and for the safety of all parties, all priority Juvenile Delinquency proceedings may be conducted remotely until further notice. Priority matters will be held by videoconference/phone during the COVID-19 pandemic, using **Zoom**.

- Juvenile court matters are confidential unless otherwise provided by law. Recording any portion of the hearing is prohibited. No information regarding the hearing can be shared with any person unless authorized by law. Violation of these provisions may result in criminal and/or monetary sanctions.
- Judges, staff and parties shall appear remotely.
- Because this hearing will be held remotely, no documents will be accepted at the time of the hearing.
- Appearing by Zoom <u>is free to all parties</u> and you can appear <u>by video or by</u> <u>phone</u>. Any recording of the hearing is prohibited.
