**GUADALUPE GUERRA**, brother, is Petitioner and requests appointment as [Successor] Conservator of the Person, with authority to change the proposed Conservatee's residence.

**Petitioner states** the proposed Conservatee was born with [Down syndrome and is severely mentally retarded], he is disabled and has never been able to care for himself since birth, and he has always needed a family member to care for him. Petitioner states the Conservatee lives with one of his brothers, **MARIO GUERRA**, who has not provided for the Conservatee's needs and has placed him in danger by surrounding him with persons abusing alcohol and drugs, and there is also gang activity in the home. Petitioner states the Conservatee's brother Mario is supposed to be taking care of the financial matters of the Conservatee, but is misusing the Conservatee's funds.

**Petitioner requests** authority to change the Conservatee's residence from the back house on their property to the front house on their property in order to bring the home in which he resides up to "sub-code" and to clean the property to make it livable.

**Court Investigator Julie Negrete's Report was filed on 10/24/2012 and recommends that the Petitioner, Guadalupe Guerra, be appointed as successor Conservator.**

NEEDS/PROBLEMS/COMMENTS, continued:

**Note:** The general *Petition* states at Item 4(b) that the Conservatee is receiving or is entitled to receive benefits from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, and that the estimated amount of monthly benefits is "unknown." Court may seek clarification as to whether the Conservatee receives or may be entitled to receive Veterans Benefits by virtue of some unidentified source, or whether this information was included in error. Receipt of Veterans Benefits by the Conservatee would require 15 days' notice to be served to the Department of Veterans Affairs pursuant to Probate Code § 1822(d), even though the Petitioner is not seeking conservatorship of the estate of the Conservatee.

Notes for background:

- **Minute Order dated 10/10/2012** from the hearing on the petition for appointment of temporary conservator states in pertinent part: Counsel advises the Court that Mario Guerra is in the hospital. The Court indicates for the *Minute Order* that it is removing Mario Guerra as the Conservator based on his inability to care for the Conservatee. The Court grants the petition and appoints Guadalupe Guerra as temporary Conservator of the person. The temporary expires on 11/7/2012. The general hearing remains set for 11/7/2012. Counsel is directed to prepare an order for the removal of Mario Guerra as Conservator.
- **Court Investigator Julie Negrete's Report filed on 10/9/2012** indicates the CVRC case manager reported that the Conservatee's involvement with CVRC was terminated in September 2012 as requested by Mario Guerra (former Conservator) who informed her that the Conservatee no longer wanted to attend his day program; the Conservatee had attended the ARC Adult Day Program in Kerman for over 10 years but was dropped on 8/23/2012. *CI Report* indicates that the ARC had been contacted by Adult Protective Services inquiring how to re-enroll the Conservatee back into the day program, but ARC was later informed the Conservatee did not want to attend.

Ms. Harris reports that Jarvis has violent outbursts, refused to take his medications, and was violent towards property and himself. Petitioners were instructed by Jarvis's psychiatrist to contact the police or take him to the hospital if he was out of control and a danger to himself. In June, Jarvis was admitted to Johns Hopkins Adolescent Psychiatric Ward. On the way to the hospital Jarvis had to be restrained because he attempted to jump out of the car on the freeway. Jarvis was then enrolled in a daily outpatient psychiatric hospital at Johns Hopkins. He had several outbursts while at the hospital and at home. Dr. Carolyn Howell told Petitioners that Jarvis has Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder; a Disruptive Behavior Disorder; speech and language deficits; borderline intellectual functioning; left sided hearing loss; indications of severe abuse, neglect, homelessness, and transitions and a "parent-child relationship problem." Petitioners fear Jarvis will harm them or one of their children. As a result they have been hiding knives and other sharp items that could be used as a weapon. Jammy is not violent in the way Jarvis is, but exhibits disruptive behavior, jealousy and destructive bickering with Petitioner's other children. Ms. Harris states, despite ongoing, earnest efforts at incorporating Jarvis and Jammy into the family, it has proved an insurmountable task. Ms. Harris states the price they are paying is the degradation of their marriage, the collapse of a stable household, and the loss of their peace of mind. The stress has proven too difficult for their family to handle.

**Petitioners pray for an order:**

1. That the Court approve the resignation of Petitioners as the guardians of the Wards, with such resignation to be effective immediately;
2. That the Court authorize Petitioners to deliver the minors to Child Protective Services, either in California or Maryland, or another appropriate agency until a successor guardianship can be established;
3. That the guardianship of the Wards be transferred to a therapeutic foster service.
