NEEDS/PROBLEMS/COMMENTS: The following items were previously noted, and have been addressed in the Supplemental Report as indicated below. These items remain noted for consideration:

1. Receipts include Shell Oil dividends; however, the Inventory and Appraisals filed in the conservatorship do not indicate ownership of securities. The Court may require clarification or supplemental I&A.
2. The Court may require clarification regarding the disbursements for the "VC Trissell Lease" (total \$1,597.67).

Re #1 and #2 above: Supplemental Report filed 1-20-15 states the references in the distributions to "VC Trissell Lease" represent the conservatee's interest in oil and gas rights in a well in Beckham County, OK. Attached as Exhibit A is a copy of the "Authorization to Receive Oil and Direction for Payment" dated 12-29-14, which confirms the "pay status" in this ownership interest in said property, representing the Conservatee's 0.0176594% interest in the well. The "rental payments" due for the conservatee's interest are to the well owner (VC Trissell) and the payments to the Conservatee for her percentage share of the extracted oil are the "Shell Oil dividends" reported on the "Income" schedule in the accounting.

3. The Court may require clarification regarding the Derrel's Mini Storage charges of approx. \$97/month.

Supplemental Report states the Conservatee had this storage facility prior to the commencement of these proceedings and the conservator retained the unit with the Conservatee's property in it.

4. The Court may require clarification regarding the \$33 NSF charge on 8-27-13. Disbursements Schedule states "Rent check didn't go through/didn't clear."

This item does not appear to be addressed.

5. The Court may require clarification regarding the charges at Babies R Us for a shower gift (car seat) for \$146.04, with reference to Cal. Rule of Court 7.1059(b)(3).

Supplemental Report filed 1-20-15 states the Conservatee told the Conservator that she wanted to buy her a baby shower gift. The Conservator discussed her grandmother's wishes with Mr. Rindlisbacher, the Conservatee's attorney, and he stated that such a gift would be appropriate and acceptable.

6. The Court may require clarification regarding the over \$20,000.00 in attorney fees and costs incurred during this first account period with reference to Probate Code §2640(c) (just and reasonable), Cal. Rules of Court 7.756(a)(2) (benefit to the Conservatee), and Local Rule 7.16.B.1.

During the course of serving as Guardian Ad Litem, Mr. Bickel participated in one (1) conference with attorney Dowling and Diane Thompson, on 07/08/2014, during which alternatives for distribution available to Ms. Thompson in her role as Administrator. One issue was whether the Decedent's ½ interest in the house in the probate estate should be distributed in undivided one-quarter (1/4) interests to Diane Thompson and to her brother, Richard Thompson. Mr. Bickel asserted that such a distribution did not appear to be in the best interest of Richard Thompson for the reason that: (a) Diane Thompson is currently living in the house and the two siblings have a history of conflict and physical altercation which makes an amicable co-ownership of the residence ill-advised; and (b) Richard Thompson has evidenced no interest to live in the Decedent's house in any residential property. Another issue raised by Diane Thompson was her preference for some type of "protected" form of distribution under which Richard Thompson would not be able to "squander" his inheritance, such as funding to a trust to be established for his benefit, or such as the establishment of a Conservator for his estate. Declarant insisted that, while her intentions for fiscal protection of her brother's inheritance were admirable, there is no indication from her brother that such measures are necessary or desired by him; furthermore, Declarant stated that she would be exceeding her authority as Administrator to implement such measures on her own initiative.

During the course of serving as Guardian Ad Litem, Mr. Bickel participated in two (2) telephone conferences with Ms. Thompson, on 07/17/2014 and 07/18/2014, during which discussions regarding her personal preferences for a distribution in which some protective measures could be taken, versus the inevitability of an outright distribution to Richard Thompson. Declarant attempted to diffuse the weight of familial obligations as expressed by Ms. Thompson for her brother's best interests by explaining that she is under legal and fiduciary obligations that make fulfillment of her expressed familial responsibilities impossible. Declarant explained that she could not suggest to the Court anything other than an outright distribution without consent of the Guardian Ad Litem, and Mr. Bickel assured her that he could not offer such consent.

On 08/19/2014, Mr. Bickel received a call from Richard Thompson (who had been given Mr. Bickel's name and number by attorney Dowling). Mr. Bickel spoke at length with Mr. Thompson about (a) the reason for the appointment of a Guardian Ad Litem; (b) the probate cancellation of the Guardian Ad Litem appointment if he would agree to participate in matters relating to a review of the Administrator's accounting and the receipt of his inheritance; (c) the legal procedures in probate by which his share of the estate will be distributed to him; (d) his right to request partial interest in the residence or to opt for a full cash distribution; and (e) alternatives *which he may choose* – such as funding into a trust that he would establish or to a designated attorney-in-fact – which may be far more advantageous for a person who is living on the streets and has no permanent residence. Mr. Thompson said he would prefer that Mr. Bickel remain as the Guardian Ad Litem and continue to insist on all-cash distribution to be made to him. At the time he was considering the cash distribution could be delivered to his Social Security payee, but he indicated that he might change his mind about how the receipt of the cash could be handled. He was definite in his rejection of any notion of placing his estate proceeds in any type of trust or other legal arrangement.

On 10/20/2014, Mr. Bickel spoke with attorney Dowling, who indicated that Richard Thompson had told his sister, Administrator Diane Thompson, that he had decided he wants his cash distributed from the estate to be deposited into the existing savings account in his name at Valley First Credit Union.

As Guardian Ad Litem, Mr. Bickel agrees that making the distribution in this manner will be consistent with Richard Thompson's clear directive that he wants to take possession of his funds from the estate without the involvement of any middleman or any "strings attached." Mr. Bickel agrees that a deposit of the funds to be distributed outright to Richard Thompson into his account at Valley First Credit Union will avoid the problem of attempting to find Mr. Thompson to otherwise make a personal delivery; furthermore, it allows the Administrator to make a timely disposition of the funds rather than holding them for an indefinite period of time waiting for Mr. Thompson to surface.

Mr. Bickel expended a total of 4.4 hours working on the matters in this case, as described above, including the time for the preparation of this Declaration. Mr. Bickel states his normal hourly rate for fiduciary services is \$175 per hour. He believes a reasonable fee for his services is \$770. He believes he rendered a beneficial service to and for Richard Thompson, who essentially held himself incommunicado with the Administrator, and without the appointment of a Guardian Ad Litem, the administration of the estate could have been made complicated and prolonged.
