DOD: 06/05/2009		<p>PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR, successor administrator, is petitioner.</p> <p>Background: ROCKY BUCCI, was appointed administrator on 07/28/2009. The primary asset of the estate is a house and mobile home in Sanger, which both appraised at \$67,800. There is a mortgage on the property with an outstanding balance of approximately \$70,000. Rocky Bucci has been maintaining the property and making all the mortgage payments.</p> <p>Rocky Bucci and his two brothers, Dino Bucci and Anthony Bucci are the three heirs of the estate. Rocky Bucci had hoped to purchase the property from the estate, or reach an agreement with his brothers whereby he would receive distribution of the real property of the estate.</p> <p>Rocky Bucci failed to timely file the First and Final Account and it became apparent to Attorney Horton that Mr. Bucci did not want to sell the property. Petitioner states: The same property that was listed on the I&A remains part of the estate. Rocky Bucci has paid all expenses related to the real and personal property, as well as several thousand dollars for the decedent's funeral. The total expenses as of the filing of this account is \$27,128.35. The real property is valued at \$60,000.00 and according to the declaration filed by Attorney Sanoian on 02/02/2012 there is an outstanding mortgage of \$70,000.

The house, vehicles and furnishings could not be sold for anywhere near the amount Rocky Bucci has paid to maintain those assets. As noted the house could not be sold at all. Had he not continued to pay the mortgage from September 2009 to present, the house would have been lost to foreclosure. Due to the lack of value in the assets as compared to the amount of reimbursement to which Rocky Bucci would be entitled, petitioner proposes that the real property, vehicles, and furnishings be distributed to Rocky Bucci.

Petitioner prays for an Order:

1. The administration of the estate of the decedent is brought to a close.
2. The estate consists of the original assets: one parcel of real property, two vehicles, and household furniture and furnishings.
3. Payment of attorney fees to Joanne Sanoian in the amount of \$1,293.00 is to be made by Rocky Bucci.
4. Distribution of all assets in the estate shall be distributed to Rocky Bucci, and become his sole property.

Petitioner states, continued:

- The grandchildren pushed past the Petitioner with the proposed Conservatee and took her in the middle of the night to their home and they would not let Petitioner speak with her when Petitioner called;
- Petitioner called for police assistance but she did not know the actual address where the proposed Conservatee was taken;
- The proposed Conservatee is diabetic and none of the people caring for her have any experience or knowledge of how to care for her; Petitioner is concerned that the proposed Conservatee could be very ill or die because of lack of medical care;
- The proposed Conservatee's grandchildren who took her will have access to her bank account and they all have prior [records] for drugs and alcohol and will take her money.

Court Investigator Jo Ann Morris' Report was filed on 4/11/2013.

Objection to Conservatorship filed by Sherri Gillespie, granddaughter, on 4/2/2013 states:

- Her grandmother [proposed Conservatee, Margie Tyler] was brought here [California] with Petitioner's husband without the permission of proposed Conservatee's daughter, Wilma Bolton, from Oklahoma;
- Proposed Conservatee's son, Jerry Tyler, is with the proposed Conservatee while she is objecting to this attempt for guardianship;
- She doesn't know what date the proposed Conservatee arrived, but she received a phone call from Kathy Gillespie saying their grandmother [proposed Conservatee] is at Petitioner's home;
- She went to see their grandmother on 3/26/2013 after hearing news of her being here on Monday night, 3/25/2013;
- When she went to Petitioner's home, the proposed Conservatee looked as if she was drugged and the Petitioner was feeding her a peanut butter and jelly sandwich;
- Petitioner was making dinner for her and mixing up pudding and cookies in it; at this time I was not aware of the proposed Conservatee's Type 2 diabetes; she thought she was being drugged;
- She then took the proposed Conservatee to her house and made a doctor's appointment, and she called the proposed Conservatee's daughter at that time;
- At this time, proposed Conservatee is on medication and doing very well;
- Petitioner does not believe in medicine, and Petitioner informed her that the proposed Conservatee was seeing a healing doctor that prays for her;
- Wilma Bolton, proposed Conservatee's daughter, will be flying here within a week to fly the proposed Conservatee back home, and proposed Conservatee's daughter and son would like the proposed Conservatee to stay in her care until then;
- Petitioner is mad at the proposed Conservatee for taking George [relationship not stated] in three months ago, and she thinks Petitioner is trying to make the proposed Conservatee ill by not giving her medication;
- She spoke to the proposed Conservatee two weeks before she arrived here [in California] and she was in her right mind; now she is not, and this same thing happened in Petitioner's and George's care; she thinks they are feeding her sugar and not giving her medication;

Objection to Conservatorship filed 4/2/20 13 by Sherri Gillespie, continued:

- Petitioner is in financial trouble because her daughter, Paula, took her schizophrenic son away from her because George the boyfriend was abusing him;
- Petitioner's sister, Rowena Stidham, said George raped him and Petitioner caught him and did nothing about it;
- Everyone is afraid that Petitioner is going to hurt the proposed Conservatee; her hope and prayers are that [someone] will call her or the proposed Conservatee's children if needed;
- She only has the proposed Conservatee for another week;
- The proposed Conservatee took her [Objector's] mother and four sisters in when she was 11 years old and the proposed Conservatee is like a mother to her and she would never hurt her;
- When Petitioner's sister Rowena called her, she called Jerry Tyler, proposed Conservatee's son, right away and she came down [to the Court] so she could object;
- She is a good person and she works at Fresno State in the resident's dining hall; she does not have any criminal past as the Petitioner may have stated;
- Petitioner's daughter called Rowena and warned her about Petitioner being at the Courthouse trying to get the proposed Conservatee;
- She is sorry that she has to write this telling the Court that her aunt is crazy, but it is the truth;
- She thanks the Court for taking time to consider her side of the story.

Petitioner states, continued:

- She is a long-time family friend of the children's mother, the children know her as their aunt, and she has been with them through many episodes and has always been reliable to the children;
- The children have lived in her home for two years and Allias' grades have dramatically improved in the two years he has lived with her;
- The mother has no home for the children now, she is fighting to get back her 4 other children, and does not have a bond with the children since she has been in prison; the mother has no means without the children's welfare money;
- The mother tried to pick up the children on 4/2/2013 and the oldest child refused to go and trashed his room when the mother refused to leave without him; Petitioner's husband calmed the child down and he was O.K. once he didn't have to leave home;
- Both children are emotionally damaged and traumatized by the mother and Mr. Hall.

Petitioner requests: The Court excuse her from giving notice to Theodor Yancy, father of Allias, as he has not been around for at least 5 years or more; and to Blakki A. Hall, Sr., father of Blakki Jr., as he has been absent from his son's life for the past two years and even though he knows where his son is and has been to Fresno 10 times, he never bother to see him.

Objection to Guardianship filed by Ashanti R. Jackson, mother, on 4/9/2013 states:

- She and her children's fathers are not incarcerated or dead;
- None of them were notified of this matter;
- Her children are unsafe with the person who petitioned for the guardianship;
- On 3/31/2012, her son, Allias Yancy, was asked at 10:00 p.m. to leave the Petitioner's home; she was not notified for over an hour and a half;
- The Petitioner kept her sons from her the entire time she was incarcerated; she was released on 3/24/2013;
- The Petitioner keeps leaving her text messages stating basically that she has to do what she says;
- She objects to the guardianship; her 15-year-old son does not want to be there;
- The Petitioner never served any of the parents any paperwork nor notified anyone of Court dates;
- She feels her children will be in great danger if left with the Petitioner;
- She is capable of taking care of her children;
- The Petitioner is a non-relative; she has hit her 15-year-old;
- When she did see her children, her 15-year-old had on dirty clothes and shoes with holes in them;
- Her 1-year-old stays ill and keeps a diaper rash [because of] Petitioner;
- On 4/8/2013, her 1-year-old was vomiting and the Petitioner took him to the day care instead of to the doctor to be taken care of;
- The Petitioner refuses phone calls from her, her son's fathers, and other family.
