A settlement conference was held that resulted in the Conservator receiving the requested reimbursement and that Petitioner was to remain as the Court appointed counsel for the Conservatee.

He is also the current income beneficiary of the W. DYCK IRREVOCABLE TRUST, created by Velma H. Dyck, as settlor, on 12/30/08 (the "W. Dyck Trust"), (collectively "Trusts").</li> <li>2. Petitioner is the current acting trustee of each of the Trusts and has the authority under Section 6.1 (a) of each of the Trusts to appoint successor trustees. No successor trustees are currently designated for either trust.</li> <li>3. The withdrawal beneficiaries pursuant to Section 4.1 of each of the Trusts are identical.</li> <li>4. 7. As of 01/01/13, the grantor trust treatment of the William A. Dyck Trust has been terminated.
8. Because the William A. Dyck Trust is no longer a defective grantor trust, the two separate trusts are no longer necessary.
9. The terms of the Trusts are substantially similar.
10. Petitioner's administrative duties would be simplified, and therefore less costly, if the Trusts were combined into a single trust, to be called the "W. Dyck Irrevocable Trust."
11. Combining the Trusts would not impair the accomplishment of the trust purposes or the interests of the trust beneficiaries.
