Petitioners are not able to obtain information or change her bus schedule to her new residence without guardianship. Petitioners state the mother does not have a relationship with Liz and has not seen her for at least two years. The mother resides in Modesto in a rundown poorly-maintained home, and there are other individuals who live there who do not appear to be good influences for Liz.

She receives assistance for Liz' brother Zachary, but he will turn 18 soon and Petitioners are afraid she will attempt to get custody of Liz, especially since Liz will now receive benefits from her father's social security.
