NEEDS/PROBLEMS/COMMENTS:

4. The proposed Conservatee was previously under conservatorship with his father, Fred Amey, Sr., as conservator. According to the Court Investigator's report filed 7/17/13 in connection with the termination of the previous conservatorship, Wayne resided with his father and step-mother, Dorothy Amey. After his father passed away in 2012, he continued to reside with his step-mother Dorothy Amey. Dorothy Amey did not feel there was a need for a successor conservator to be appointed because she had not had any issues in ensuring that Wayne's needs are met. Therefore, the conservatorship was terminated.

At this time, although Dorothy Amey is a non-relative (step-mother), given the past circumstances, the Court may require Notice of Hearing with a copy of the petition to be served on her as well pursuant to Probate Code §§ 1202, 1822.
