Letters issued 10/3/14.</p> <p>At the hearing on 5/27/14, the Court set this status hearing for the filing of the first account or petition for final distribution.</p> <p>Note re history: The following events have occurred in this estate:</p> <p>I&A Partial No. 1 filed 9/5/14 includes various real property with a total value of \$250,000.00. <i>Note: This I&A is defective. #5 (Property Tax Certificate) is checked "not applicable," however, that is not the case, because this I&A consists of real property.</i></p> <p>No Final I&A has been filed.</p> <p>On 1/28/15, the Court confirmed the sale of one of the properties and ordered the proceeds placed into a blocked account. Receipt was filed 3/3/15.</p> <p>On 6/19/15, the Co-Executors filed an Ex Parte Petition for Withdrawal of Funds from Blocked Account that requested distribution of the funds in the blocked account to the beneficiaries. 3. This petition, filed 7/8/15, states notice was given to the Victim's Compensation and Government Claims Board. A Status Report subsequently filed 7/16/15 states inquiry regarding one of the beneficiaries (Teodoro Garza Garza) is pending. Need update on this inquiry.

Through counsel, Co-Administrator Charlton Moore agreed to advance her airfare to return again to Fresno so long as the advance is charged against her share of the estate. He is also willing to hire a third party to remove the balance and place it in storage in her name. However, Co-Administrator Charlton Moore requests that the status hearing be continued for no more than 60 days to determine whether the personal property ah been removed from the estate. Second Status Report filed 8/3/15 by Charlton W. Moore states after receiving the \$1,000.00 advance from the estate, Lorene E. Moore removed her tangible personal property from the decedent's residence. A realtor has been retained to market the property, but an agreement has not yet been signed. The realtor obtained two bids for trash removal, which took place on 7/29/15. The next step is to have it cleaned before it can be shown to prospective buyers. Charlton believes it is in the best interest of the estate to conclude a sale of the real estate prior to making final distribution, and requests the court continue the status hearing for no more than 120 days to determine whether the sale is proceeding smoothly.

Supplemental Status Hearing Report filed 8/4/15 by Lorene E. Moore states she traveled to Fresno from her home in Texas and removed remaining tangible personal property from the residence. The residence has been cleared of debris and prepared for sale. A listing/marketing agreement has been signed with Guarantee Real Estate. The court is requested to allow the co-administrators to continue administration to allow time to sell the real property. An additional 120-180 days is requested.
