Due to the transition to a new case management system, the Fresno Superior Court hereby announces its proposal to temporarily consolidate cases and all essential hearings to be heard only in the Main Courthouse and the Juvenile Justice Courthouse, on the following date: March 30, 2026. In addition, Clerk's Offices will be consolidated into the Main Courthouse and the Juvenile Justice Courthouse.

These changes are a result of the Court's strategic planning for operational efficiency during the transition of case management systems. The closure will allow the court to test the newly implemented case management system to ensure that all data properly converted over, that all filings submitted in the work queues have been processed and that the new system is functioning properly and efficiently before opening all clerk's offices to the public. This one-day closure will allow additional staff to be utilized to trouble shoot and correct any potential issues with the conversion. The temporary relocation of the departments from the B.F. Sisk and "M" Street Courthouses to the Main Courthouse and the Juvenile Justice Courthouse on this date will provide the Court with the opportunity to better utilize staff resources.
