**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE
One-Time Infraction Amnesty Program
(Vehicle Code section 42008.7)**

The program begins January 1, 2012, and ends June 30, 2012.

All adult and juvenile Vehicle Code and Non-Vehicle Code infraction violations which were due to be paid before January 1, 2009 are eligible.

To qualify for the 50 percent discount, all of the following conditions must be met:

- 1. You have failed to appear in court or failed to pay in full on or before January 1, 2009;**
- 2. The last date you made a payment was on or before January 1, 2009;**
- 3. You do not owe victim restitution on any case within Fresno County; and**
- 4. You do not have any outstanding misdemeanor or felony warrants within Fresno County.**

If you feel you meet the conditions listed above, you will need to fill out an Eligibility Affidavit. (Form number TTR-60). This form must be signed and submitted to the walk-up Infraction Amnesty Window located at the Fresno Superior Court, 1100 Van Ness Ave, along with half (50%) of the amount owed on your case. Monies will be placed into a trust until verification of eligibility is confirmed.

- If your case is determined to be ineligible for Amnesty, you will be notified in writing within 35 Court days.**
- If your case is determined to be ineligible for Amnesty, any payment made today will be applied in the following order:**
 - 1) To any Fresno County case with court ordered victim restitution owing.**
 - 2) To the balance owing on your Infraction case.**
- You will be responsible for the remaining balance.**
- If your case is determined to be eligible for Amnesty, the qualifying payment made today will be applied to your case and will be deemed paid in full.**
