## **COURT LAUNCHES WI-FI FOR JURORS, ATTORNEYS AND PUBLIC**

Fresno Superior Court is the newest hotspot facility with the introduction of public wireless Internet in its downtown courthouse. Jurors can use their laptop, personal digital assistant (PDA) or other wireless-ready device to access the Internet while they await their turn in the jury selection process. Attorneys can now connect to their offices while waiting at the court. The court is proud to offer this free service to its jurors, attorneys, and the public so that their time waiting to serve or conduct court business is comfortable, productive and convenient.

To use the Wi-Fi service, one simply has to bring a wireless-ready device when they come to Court. Anyone using the service should take every reasonable security precaution to protect the data in their computers. *The Court assumes no responsibility* in regards to security failures within this Wi-Fi public access network. Wireless public Internet access is also available at the Civil Courthouse, Juvenile Dependency Court and at the Probate Clerk's Office at the Trade Center building. Future plans for WiFi include the Juvenile Delinquency Court and the Sisk Court facility.
