

CALIFORNIA STATE COURT SYSTEM

Announces One Day a Month Closure

In light of the unprecedented financial situation facing the State of California, the Judicial Council of California has announced that pursuant to Government Code section 68106 all state courts will be closed to the public on the third Wednesday of every month through the remainder of this fiscal year.

The Fresno Superior Court will be closed to public on the following days:

Wednesday, September 16, 2009
Wednesday, October 21, 2009
Wednesday, November 18, 2009
Wednesday, December 16, 2009
Wednesday, January 20, 2010
Wednesday, February 17, 2010
Wednesday, March 17, 2010
Wednesday, April 21, 2010
Wednesday, May 19, 2010
Wednesday, June 16, 2010

No more matters will be scheduled on these dates. Previously set matters will either be continued to another date or trailed to the following Thursday. If you are scheduled for a court appearance on any of these dates, please contact the clerk's office at (559) 457-2000 for a new court date.

Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section 68106, the closure days will be treated as holidays for the purpose of scheduling hearings and calculating time for statutory and filing deadlines.
