In the interest of justice, for the safety of individuals attending the proceedings of the aforementioned case, and to preserve the dignity of the court and the integrity of the proceedings, the Court orders the following:

1. There shall be no cameras, tape recorders, video recorders, camcorders, laptop or other computers permitted in the courtroom. Cellular phones, personal digital assistants, satellite phones or any other manual or electronic device capable of recording video, audio or still images, or any device capable of recording video, audio or still images, or any device capable of transmitting any visual or audio representation or actual image or sound shall not be permitted in the courtroom. Cellular

1 phones or personal digital assistants that do not have the
2 capabilities above will be permitted in the courtroom so long as
3 they are turned off or on silent mode.

4 2. No bags, packages, briefcases, boxes or any other
5 container shall be brought into the trial courtroom. Media
6 representatives and counsel of record and counsel's agents may be
7 exempted in order to permit necessary support materials.

8 3. No prejudicial or inflammatory logos, insignia or
9 paraphernalia of any kind shall be worn on any person or clothing
10 while in the courtroom.

11 4. No members of the media or public shall be
12 permitted beyond the railing, separating the court gallery from
13 the litigation area.

14 5. Persons, other than the parties or their agents,
15 shall not be permitted to enter the courtroom while court is in
16 session. Entry shall be only before court convenes and during
17 announced breaks in the proceedings. Persons may exit at any
18 time.

19 6. No interviews shall be held in the trial courtroom
20 at any time.

21 7. No disruptions, interferences, outbursts, public
22 demonstration, loud or intrusive noises or distractions shall be
23 permitted in the trial courtroom at any time. Anyone who does
24 not comply with this condition will be immediately removed from
25 the courtroom, and may forfeit access for the duration of the
26 case.

27 8. Anyone who does not comply with all conditions of
28 this order may forfeit access to the courtroom for a specified

1 time or for the duration of the case, or the violation of this
2 order may result in the violator being held in contempt of court
3 and/or being subject to monetary sanction pursuant to California
4 Civil Code of Procedure 177.5.

5 9. This order is subject to modification at any time.
