18 On March 17, 2004, the Court provided electronic notice

19 to the parties and posted notice to the Public on the court Web

20 site of the Court's intent to permit remote electronic access to

21 all or a portion of the public court records in the case of *People*

22 *v. Marcus Wesson*, Superior Court Case Number: F04901785-6 Notice

23 was provided Pursuant to California Rule of Court 2073.5(d)

24 [*Remote electronic access allowed in individual criminal cases*].

25 Five days having elapsed since notice to the parties and the

26 public, the Court makes the following order:

27 Due to the extraordinarily high number of requests for

28 access to documents in the *Wesson* case and the resultant


1 significant burden placed upon the operations of the court in
2 responding to those requests, the Court, having considered the
3 factors in Rule 2073.5(b), hereby exercises its discretion
4 permitting remote electronic access to all court records in the
5 *Wesson* case excepting that confidential records will not be
6 posted, nor records that have not been redacted as described in
7 Rule 2073.5(c).

8 Specifically, the following information shall be
9 redacted from records before remote access is allowed: driver
10 license numbers; dates of birth; social security numbers; Criminal
11 Identification and Information and National Crime Information
12 numbers; addresses, and phone numbers of parties, victims,
13 witnesses, and court personnel; medical and psychiatric
14 information; financial information; account numbers; and other
15 personal identifying information.

16 Pursuant to Rule 2073.5(c), it is ordered that any party
17 who files a document containing such information shall provide the
18 court with both an original unredacted version of the document for
19 filing in the court file and a redacted version of the document
20 for remote electronic access.

21 It is further ordered that no juror names or other juror
22 identifying information may be provided by electronic access.
