Pursuant to adjournment of June 2, 2005, Court reconvenes at 9:03 a.m. The People represented by Lisa Gamoian, Chief Deputy District Attorney, and the defendant, Marcus Delon Wesson, with counsel, Peter Jones, Chief Public Defender and Rafael Torres, Deputy Public Defender are present. All parties state that they are ready to proceed. The jury panel is not present.

Court Reporter, Denise Dedmon is present at 9:00 a.m.

Outside the presence of the jury, The Court inquires of defense counsel what the reference point is on the transcript for the parts of the digital recording that will be played in closing arguments. Defense counsel provides the Court with the reference points.

Media request for camera's at the time of the verdict is denied by the Court.

Court reconvenes at 9:08 a.m. in the courtroom with all parties present and the jury in their seats.

Rafael Torres, Deputy Public Defender, resumes with closing argument on behalf of the defendant, Marcus Delon Wesson at 9:08 a.m.

The Court admonishes the jury and stands in recess at 10:20 a.m.

Court Reporter Kristi Garcia replaces Denise Dedmon at 10:40 a.m.

The Court reconvenes at 10:40 a.m. with all parties present and the jury in their seats.

Rafael Torres, Deputy Public Defender, continues with closing arguments on behalf of the defendant, Marcus Delon Wesson at 10:41 a.m.

The Court admonishes the jury and the jury stands in recess at 11:58 a.m.

Outside the presence of the jury, the Court and respective counsel discuss the Peoples objection to statements made by defense. The Court request of defense counsel to provide the page numbers in the transcripts that support his statement.

The Court stands in recess at 12:01 p.m.

Court Reporter Denise Dedmon replaces Kristi Garcia at 1:50 p.m.

The Court reconvenes at 1:50 p.m. with all parties present and the jury in their seats.

Rafael Torres, Deputy Public Defender, continues with closing arguments on behalf of the defendant, Marcus Delon Wesson at 1:51 p.m. Argument on behalf of the defendant concludes at 2:22 p.m.

Lisa Gamoian, Chief Deputy District Attorney, begins rebuttal closing argument at 2:22 p.m. on behalf of the people.

The Court admonishes the jury and stands in recess at 2:44 p.m.

Court Reporter Kristi Garcia replaces Denise Dedmon at 3:01 p.m.

The jury returns to the courtroom at 3:01 p.m. and the trial continues.

Lisa Gamoian, Chief Deputy District Attorney, resumes her rebuttal closing argument to the jury on behalf of the people beginning at 3:01 p.m. and concludes at 3:53 p.m.

The Court gives the final instructions to the jury beginning at 3:54 p.m. and concludes at 4:03 p.m.

The jury, in the custody of a sworn deputy, retires to the juryroom to begin deliberations at 4:05 p.m.,

Outside the presence of the jury, the Court orders respective counsel to be present on June 3, 2005 at 10:00 a.m. The also inquires from respective counsel if 2 copies of the jury instructions may be given to the jury. Defense stipulates and the people reserves.

The Court adjourns at 4:15 p.m.

Outside the presence of the Court and respective counsel, the jurors are released at 4:30 p.m. until June 3, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. for further deliberations.

The defendant remains remanded to the custody of the Sheriff pending the next hearing date.
