At 9:30 a.m., the foreperson notifies Deputy Henry Franco that a verdict has been reached. Also, the Court receives a Request of the Jury.

Outside the presence of the jury, " In Chambers" conference is held at 10:40 a.m. with Lisa Gamoian, Chief Deputy District Attorney, on behalf of the People. Rafael Torres, Deputy Public Defender and Peter Jones, Chief Deputy Public Defender are present on behalf of Marcus Delon Wesson who is present with the aid of an electronic listening device. The Court and respective counsel take up the matter of the request of the jury. The parties agree to send in a new copy of the verdict forms for Sedona Vadra Wesson.

The Court stands in recess at 10:42 a.m.

Pursuant to the adjournment of June 28, 2005, the Court reconvenes at 11:24 a.m. The People represented by Lisa Gamoian, Chief Deputy District Attorney, and the defendant, Marcus Delon Wesson with counsel Peter Jones, Chief Deputy Public Defender and Rafael Torres, Deputy Public Defender are present. All parties state that they are ready to proceed.

The Jury, at their request, enters the Courtroom at 11:24 a.m and are seated in their respective places, stating to the Court that they have agreed upon a verdict.

The Court orders the verdict to be secured and it is so secured. The Court reviews the verdict forms and finds them to be in order.

The Court orders the Clerk to read the verdict and it is so read and recorded.

The Court inquires of Counsel if either side desires a poll of the Jury. Neither party wishes for the jury to be polled.

The Court instructs the Clerk to file the verdicts as read into the record, and they are so filed. (See attachments)

The Court orders that the Juror information be sealed pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure 237.

The matter is referred to the Probation Officer for investigation, report and recommendation on July 27, 2005 at 2:00 p.m. in Dept. 53 is fixed as the time for hearing for the pronouncement of judgment and imposition of sentence. The Court further sets a Motions date of July 27, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 53. Moving Papers are to be filed by July 18, 2005 by 4:00 p.m. Response Papers are to be filed by July 22, 2005 by 4:00 p.m. The Court orders that the parties comply with Rule 35 by July 18, 2005. (See attached minute order).

The Court adjourns at 11:33 a.m. until July 27, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. for Motions and July 27, 2005 at 2:00 p.m. for RPO.

The defendant remains remanded to the custody of the Sheriff pending the next hearing date.
