SUBJECT: Emergency Bail Schedule Revisions

On October 13, 2020, the Executive Committee of the Fresno County Superior Court approved further exemptions to the Fresno County Emergency Bail Schedule. The exempted violations of law are not subject to \$0 bail, but are rather subject to the bail amounts shown below.

Added to the list of law violations exempt from the \$0 bail and their newly selected temporary bail amount are as follows:

- PC 30605, possession of assault weapons, \$100,000;
- PC 32625, possession of a machine gun, \$100,000;
- PC 29805, possession of a firearm with a prior listed felony conviction, \$50,000;
- PC 25400, carrying a concealed weapon, \$100,000;
- PC 25850, carrying a loaded firearm in public, \$100,000; and
- H&S 11370.1, possession of a firearm with drugs, \$50,000.

Additionally, the Executive Committee voted to increase the bail required for the following crimes currently exempt from the Emergency Bail Schedule. These crimes are not subject to \$0 bail, but rather require bail in the sum set forth below:

- VC 2800.2, felony evading, \$75,000;
- PC 186.22(a), gang enhancement, \$30,000;
- PC 182.22(b)(1)(A), gang enhancement, \$30,000;
- PC 186.22(b)(1)(B), gang enhancement, \$50,000; and
- PC 186.22(b)(1)(C), gang enhancement, \$100,000.

The above changes to the Fresno County Emergency Bail Schedule are effective immediately and do not modify any other provision of the Fresno County Emergency Bail Schedule.
