UNLAWFUL DETAINER CLINIC

If you are a Tenant or Landlord with an Unlawful Detainer case and seek assistance in preparing your paperwork or learning about the court process, there is a Zoom self-help clinic that may be able to help you.

To be eligible, you must be representing yourself in the case and qualify as low income (125% or below the national poverty level). All clinic sessions are offered on a first come, first serve basis.

Intake MUST be completed 30 minutes prior to the end of any session.
