Pursuant to the provisions set forth in Government Code section 25259.7, with the approval of the Court's Executive Officer, the Fiscal Manager of this Court's Enhanced Collections Program has applied to this Court for discharge from accountability for the court-ordered debts (accounts) that it would otherwise be responsible for collecting, as set forth on the Discharge Report dated June 24, 2022, attached hereto as Exhibit A. Said Discharge Report is incorporated herein by reference, as though set forth fully and at length.

It appears to the Court that each of the aforesaid debts/accounts contained in Exhibit A are too small to justify the continued cost of collection, and/or the likelihood of collection

1 does not warrant the expense involved.

2 Good cause appearing therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that
3 pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section 25259.9,
4 this Court's Enhanced Collections Program is discharged from
5 further accountability as to each and every debt/account set forth
6 in Exhibit A, and is therefore relieved from any further
7 responsibility for collecting the aforesaid debts/accounts. This
8 Order shall have the same effect as a discharge from
9 accountability under Government Code section 25259.

10 As further provided in Government Code section 25259.9,
11 nothing in this Order shall be construed as releasing or relieving
12 any person from liability for payment of any amount for said debts
13 or delinquent accounts.

14 Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section
15 25259.9, subdivision (a), this Court's Executive Officer, as Clerk
16 of the Court, is directed to forthwith enter record of this
17 discharge in the Court case file for each debt, and to post a copy
18 of this Order of Discharge on the Court's Internet Web site for a
19 period of not less than three weeks. The Court Executive Officer,
20 or his/her designee, shall maintain a written record verifying
21 compliance with the aforesaid Order pertaining to Internet posting
22 of this Order.

23 Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section
24 25259.9, subdivision (b), within 45 days after the end of the
25 month in which this Order is executed, the Court's Executive
26 Officer shall report to the County of Fresno this discharge from
27 accountability for the court-ordered debts set forth in Exhibit A,
28 that the Court would otherwise have been responsible for

1 collecting. Said report shall, at a minimum, include for each debt
2 discharged the following information:

- 3 1. The case number;
- 4 2. Whether the case is an infraction, misdemeanor, or
5 felony;
- 6 3. The amount of the debt discharged; and,
- 7 4. The number of years since the debt became delinquent.

8 The Court Executive Officer, or his/her designee, shall
9 maintain a written record of compliance with respect to providing
10 the aforesaid report to the County of Fresno.


