GENERAL ORDER ORDER RE IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the September 16, 2021 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the September 15, 2021 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Fresno County ("Court"), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- In cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from September 20, 2021, through October 19, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
- Pursuant to the Order, the authority granted by the Order Implementing Judicial Emergency Order 9-16-21

Chief Justice supplements the authority to extend Penal Code section 1382 deadlines granted the Court in the immediately prior judicial emergency order.

- 3. Accordingly, for any case in which the time to bring a defendant to trial previously was extended under that prior emergency order, and the extended deadline falls within the above-specified time period, this order authorizes the Court to extend the previously extended deadline by up to an additional 30 days.
- 4. For any case in which the initial section 1382 deadline falls within the above specified time period and is not governed by a prior emergency order, this order authorizes the Court to extend the time to bring a defendant to trial by a total of up to 30 days.
