The Fresno Superior Court offers a number of options for resolving your traffic infraction case without coming to court. Every aspect of a traffic infraction case can be handled either online, by mail, fax, email, phone or by video conference. This includes: paying your traffic ticket, signing up for traffic school, initiating an installment payment plan, providing proof of correction, requesting an extension or appearing in front of a judicial officer for arraignment and trial.

On August 17, 2020, the Fresno Superior Court will resume hearing arraignment proceedings on traffic infraction cases. While you may appear in person at the "M" Street Courthouse, all parties are strongly encouraged to appear by video conference using the Zoom application.
