C. In Custody Defendant Sentencing

The sentencing hearing for a defendant who is in custody will be reset for twenty (20) Court days.

D. Out of Custody Defendant Sentencing

The sentencing hearing for a defendant who is out of custody will be reset for thirty (30) Court days.

E. Existing Pre-Preliminary Hearing

The existing pre-preliminary hearing for a defendant will be reset for twenty (20) Court days from the currently set date if a general time waiver has been entered. If not, counsel will be asked that a written Penal Code section 977 waiver, along with a general time waiver, be provided.

F. Existing Settlement Conference / Pre-Trial Hearing

The settlement conference / pre-trial hearing will be reset for twenty (20) Court days if a general time waiver has been entered. If not, counsel will be asked that a written Penal Code section 977 waiver, along with a general time waiver, be provided.

G. In Custody Preliminary Hearing

The preliminary hearing for a defendant who is in custody will be reset for fifteen (15) Court days.

H. Out of Custody Preliminary Hearing

The preliminary hearing for a defendant who is out of custody will be reset for twenty-eight (28) calendar days if a general time waiver has been entered. If not, counsel will be asked that a written Penal Code section 977 waiver, along with a general time waiver, be provided.

I. Jury Trials

Jury trials will be reset for sixty (60) calendar days if a general time waiver has been entered. If not, counsel will be asked that a written Penal Code section 977 waiver, along with a general time waiver, be provided.

Held to answer arraignments will be reset for thirty (30) calendar days.

K. Miscellaneous Proceedings
